PROJECT: CHAPTER 2 NUTRITION IN ANIMALS

Topic: The Way You Eat is as Important as What You Eat

It's not just about choosing healthy foods — *how* you eat them matters too. Eating slowly, chewing thoroughly, sitting upright, and being mindful during meals helps your body digest food more efficiently. Rushing, overeating, or eating while distracted can lead to indigestion, bloating, and poor nutrient absorption. So, your eating habits play an equal role in maintaining a healthy digestive system.

Research Task

- Investigate how improper chewing or eating too quickly can affect your digestion.
- Explore the impact of posture on the digestive process.

Demonstration Task

Prepare a detailed report addressing the following key points related to digestion and healthy eating habits. Be sure to organize your content clearly and support your explanations with relevant pictures or illustrations wherever possible.

- ▶ Explaining the role of proper chewing in digestion.
- ▶ Discuss the digestive problems that can result from eating too quickly, such as indigestion, bloating, and overeating.
- ▶ Examine how poor posture can lead to digestive issues such as acid reflux and gas, and connect it to long-term problems like constipation, acidity, and obesity.



1. Discover Patterns in Nature

- a. Observe or research natural objects like leaves, flowers, shells, beehives, and fruits.
- b. Identify mathematical patterns such as: Symmetry in leaves or butterflies, Spiral patterns in shells etc.
- c. Paste photos or draw pictures.
- d. Label the math involved (e.g., "This flower shows line symmetry", "This shell shows patterns and tessellations" etc).

2. Spot the Math in your favorite Games/Sport

- a. Choose any one sport (e.g., cricket, football, badminton, tennis, basketball).
- b. Make a colorful one-page write-up including:
 - The shape and size of the playing field or court (length, width, radius, etc.)
 - How scores are counted
 - Any patterns or rules that involve numbers (e.g., number of players, sets, overs, time limits)





3. Showcase Shapes and Geometry in Iconic Buildings

- a. Make a mini-report or photo collage on “Shapes & Geometry in Famous Buildings”
- b. Choose 2–3 famous buildings or monuments (e.g., Taj Mahal, Eiffel Tower, Pyramids of Egypt).
- c. Identify and describe the shapes used: Arches, domes, triangles, cylinders, cubes, symmetry, etc.
- d. Add photos or sketches.
- e. Explain what geometric concepts you see (e.g., "The dome is a hemisphere").

Kolam, a traditional South Indian art form, seamlessly blends mathematics and creativity. This intricate art, popular in Tamil Nadu, features geometric patterns, dots, and lines, often incorporating motifs like birds, animals, and celestial bodies.



- b. Explain the math you used (angles, shapes, symmetry, patterns).


5. Math in Daily Life
